What is a Passion Project

A passion project is a creative activity or endeavor you pursue because it inspires you and gives you deep satisfaction, joy and fulfillment. It tugs at your heart and pushes you to fulfill it.

Your passion project may be income generating, but that isn't the main motivation. Expressing your passion is what drives you.

Your Passion Project may be very therapeutic and also at times very stressful as you push yourself beyond the limits of who you think you are.

A Passion Project is not an escape - just the opposite. Finding and immersing in your Passion Project helps you connect more to yourself, your family, community, and G-d.

Undertaking a passion project is a transformative experience. It energizes and uplifts you, and inspires those around you with your committment and integrity.

Passion projects amplify your childhood curiosity, giving you permission to explore again, to try and sometimes fail without feeling like a failure because that's the nature of exploration.

You might think you already know what your Passion Project is, or you might think you have no idea what your Passion Project is. Either way, you will find that you are going to surprise yourself. Discovering and developing your Passion Project is going to lead you on an exciting adventure into the unknown depths and delights of your inner soul, strengths and creativity. Enjoy the journey!



You might already think you know what your Passion Project is, but that's just the beginning. It will lead you into new depths you can't even imagine until later in your journey.

If you think you have no idea what your Passion Project is, don't worry. Exploring your interests could be your passion project for now. View the search as a fun adventure and see where it leads you.

And if you have many Passion Projects, your challenge might be which one to choose to work on first or devote the most time to. The good news for multi-passionate creative women is that we can do them all, just not all at once. Part of your journey will be creating a strategy for planning, focus & time management so you can fit in everything you love.

O1

Explore the things you love to do & create.

The first step of discovering your Passion Project is to give yourself permission to expand your dreams and desires in all directions. It's time to explore the inner landscape of your soul and give yourself the space for your Passion Project to unfold.


On the next page is a template to help you create your "1,000 Things I Love" journal. You can use the template and print off 10 pages at a time (for 100) or use a fresh notebook or journal.

Make yourself a nice cup of something delicious to drink. Then sit in a lovely, quiet place and start writing as many things as you can think of that you would love to do or create. You might not be able to think of 1,000 things, but reaching for that number will help you stretch beyond the normal limits of your imagination.

Write down anything and everything that has ever interested you or that you have even a remote interest in. Include things you've already done or are doing, things you wish you could do (even if it doesn't seem possible), things you wanted to do as a child – really anything you would enjoy or are curious about or think you might love if you had the chance.

Include things you would like to do, create, collect, see, explore, find out. If you get stuck, color in the border to relax and think even more deeply.

If you use the following template, make a section in your Passion Projects Journey binder to keep them. You'll want to look back at them and add to them in the future.





Use pictures and words on your Vision Board. If the template is too small, you can cut out the elements to use on a bigger board.






TIMELINE: 12 MONTHLY GOALS





How to Find & Work with an Accountability Partner

Your Accountability Partner will be one of your greatest assets and likely become one of your closest friends who deeply understands the work of your heart and soul. You'll be helping each other stay accountable to your goals, cheer each other on, pick each other up in the dips, and celebrate each other's milestones along the way.

Sometimes total strangers become the best accountability partners. Your partner does not need to have a similar Passion Project. An outside perspective can be very helpful.

4 Ways to Find an Accountability Partner

- 1. Ask someone you feel a connection with, a friend, family member, co-worker, colleague or mentor.
- 2. Join a relevant networking, Facebook or local group and ask for one.
- 3. Look around at the groups and organizations you belong to and the events you attend. Is there someone who might be interested in doing this with you?
- 4. Hire a virtual assistant to be an accountability partner

Six Strategies for Working with Your Accountability Partner

- 1. 5 minute daily goals check-in
- 2.1 hour weekly deep mini-mastermind
- 3. Practice sessions
- 4. Co-working Focus Hour with a Shmooze Reward at the end
- 5. Beginning of the week goal-setting session
- 6. Mindset Mini-sessions

How to Start Your Own Mastermind

MASTER MIND AGENDA FOR MAT

Choose 3-5 people to join your mastermind and decide how often you want to meet.

- 1. Greet & Shmooze 5 minutes: Give tzedakah, a coin in the charity box. Appoint a leader and timekeeper.
- 2 Start with a one or two minute meditation to get focused in alignment with G-d.
- 3. Share a Torah thought and find its relevance to Passion Projects. Our Passion Projects Mastermind uses the Hayom Yom or topics in Chassidus. You can also choose an inspirational book with short daily readings and choose one for each session.
- 4. Begin the "Spotlights." Each person has 15 minutes in the spotlight- 10 minutes to present their project using the format below and 5 minutes for other people to respond. These times are flexible and can be expanded, as needed for your mastermind.
- 5. End each person's turn in the spotlight with a blessing for success and a L'Chaim.

SPOTLIGHT FORMAT

Use one or both of the following formats for each person's turn.

MAIN SPOTLIGHT FOR MAT:


- 1. Gratitude: What are you celebrating? (accomplishments)
- 2. Progress, Challenges & Milestone Celebrations
- 3. How can we support you? Would you like us to give you homework?
- 4. Group Brainstorm, Recognition & Appreciation for you

OPTIONAL ADDITION FORMAT FOR ACCOUNTABILITY:

Each mastermind participant can write and state her goals for the coming week or month. The leader can also record the goals in the chat and read them in the next session to follow up if they have been completed. These can also be written in your Whatsapp or Facebook group for comments & further assistance in between sessions.
